Leading Expert to Speak about Stangl and Fulper Potteries
The Trenton City Museum at Ellarslie Mansion
January 10, 2010

Peter Meissner, a leading authority on the early art ware of Stangl Pottery, will give a lecture and exhibit tour at Ellarslie Mansion in Cadwalader Park, Trenton, New Jersey on January 10, 2010, at 2 p.m.

The lecture is being given as part of the new exhibit "Utility and Artistry: Works of the Stangl and Fulper Potteries" at the Trenton City Museum at Ellarslie Mansion.

Mr. Meissner, of Three Bridges, New Jersey, is a major Stangl collector who has served as president of the Stangl/Fulper Collectors Club in Flemington, NJ, and has authored numerous articles about Stangl. He is the guest curator of the exhibit.

The exhibit is the largest ever of Stangl and Fulper pottery and marks the first true in-depth examination of the works of these potteries. Many rare and unique pieces, displayed in a chronological format, are on public view for the first time in two galleries on the second floor of Ellarslie Mansion.

Mr. Meissner will also be a featured speaker about the Stangl and Fulper Potteries at a symposium to be held in the auditorium of the New Jersey State Museum on Saturday, April 17, 2010, sponsored by the Potteries of Trenton Society, the State Museum, and the Trenton City Museum.

This program is made possible in part by the Mercer County Cultural and Heritage Commission through funding from the Mercer County Board of Chosen Freeholders and the New Jersey State Council on the Arts/Department of State, a partner agency of the National Endowment of the Arts.
