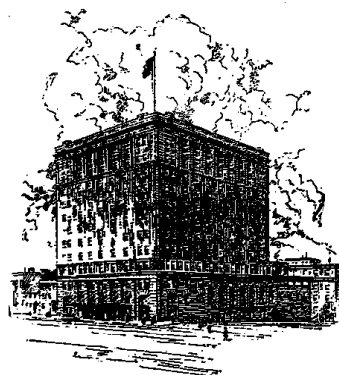

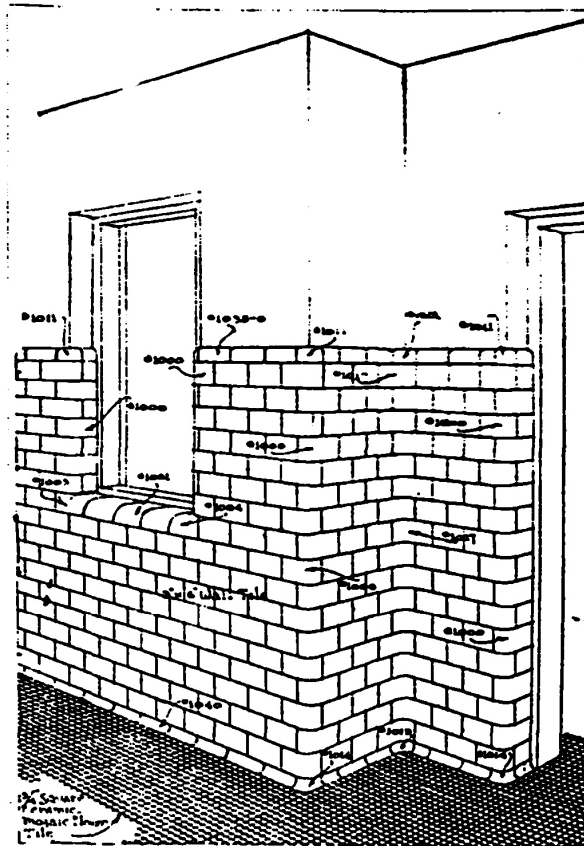

All the Refrigerators are fitted up with heavy galvanized shelves and supports throughout. All Refrigerator Doors are fitted with plate locking devices, with keys and master-keys.

All drains are of the saucer type, air-sealed, which are the most sanitary.

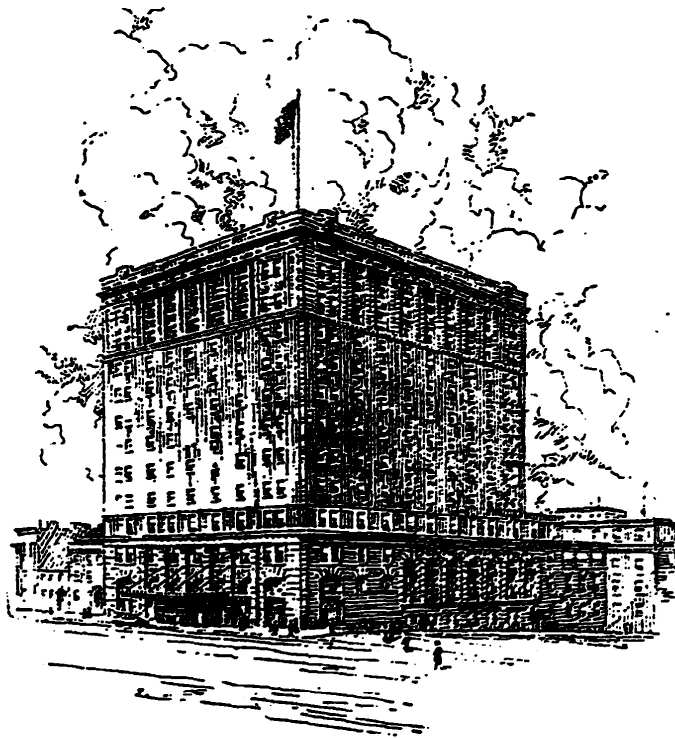

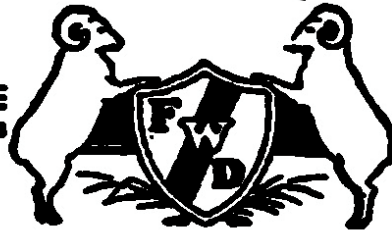

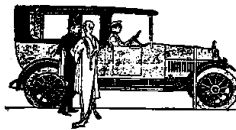
