


Sports Nite



With "Anniversary Celebration" as a theme, this year's Sports Nite program climaxed ten successive seasons of "stiff" competition by finishing in a 17-17 score. As a result of this tie, the Black team retained its lead of one year. Captains of the teams were Gloria Hill, Black team, and Anne Adams, Red team. Jane Fabian was chosen as Mistress of Ceremonies, while Miss America was portrayed by Marjorie Smith.

In accordance with its theme, the show this year presented a review of performances of previous years.
