
ROSE CONTI RED TEAM CAPTAIN

BETTY HALITSKY BLACK TEAM CAPTAIN


Betty Halitsky was chosen to captain the Black Team this year. She is a true leader and has displayed her friendliness and leadership as a member of the Leader Corps.
