History of Sport Nite

Twenty-three years ago, Dr. Paul R. Spencer, the former principal of Trenton High School, instituted a Sport Nite program to display the athletic activities that our girls were doing in their regular physical education classes. His primary purpose was to give the girls a chance to demonstrate to the public the kind of sportsmanship and leadership being taught in the school.

The first performance was presented on April 2, 1935, to a capacity crowd for one night only. As the years passed, Sport Nite became bigger and better. A theme was introduced with costumes, music, dances, and cheers, interwoven to form a definite pattern, originated and developed by the girls under the guidance of committees.

The popularity of the show grew to such an extent that after a few years the competition and spirit became so keen that the girls began selecting their teams as far back as the seventh grade. Tickets for the performances became as much in demand as those for a smash hit on Broadway. Both the public and the girls loved it. Today, Sport Nite is an established part of the community. Each year when the alma maters are sung, former team captains and loyal alumnae stand everywhere in the audience and relive one of the memories presented below:
