Trenton High Exhibit Hosts Teachers' Tales

Trenton - The Trenton Museum Society, in cooperation with Trenton Central High School, is hosting "Teachers' Tales" on Sunday, November 21, at 2 P.M. at the Trenton City Museum in Ellarslie Mansion in Cadwalader Park, Trenton, in conjunction with the current exhibit "Trenton High Through the Years."

Three long-time teachers at Trenton Central High School will tell stories from the classroom ... and the gym, the cafeteria and the halls. They include Sam Davis, administration, Greg Gunzelman, science, and Jack Washington, history.

"Trenton High Through the Years" showcases the magnificent history of Trenton High School, from the first high school on Mercer Street in 1874 to the current architectural masterpiece built in 1932 on Chambers Street. The exhibit runs through December 30.

The exhibit highlights over 30 years of Sport Nite, championship football, swimming and robotics teams, Senior class trips to Washington, D.C. in the 1920's and 1930's, "Bobashela" yearbooks from 1921 to the present, famous alumni who have been or are currently nationally prominent, and memorabilia from the 1880's to the present.
